Pre-Conference Questions and Answers

- Q1.** “The National Phlebotomy Association is interested in applying for the RFP#EDC-WSD 013-11/11 servicing the target population 16 – 21 ages?”
- A1.** All Offerors may apply for the RFP#EDC-WSD 013-11/11 provided that they meet the requirements outlined in the solicitation. The service provider must offer the youth services identified in the scope of work with established partners.

- Q2.** “Does the determination of the 2 year additional potential opportunity as a result of performance during the 18 month program solely depend upon the level of performance itself or the funds available to continue an additional 2 years or both? In other words, if there are no funds to continue 2 years additional if desired after review of the program’s performance, is there an overriding understanding that contingency plans or sources of other funding should be sought by the Offerer during their 18 year period as well to continue the great work in the community.”
- A2.** The two year contract renewal option is dependent upon the attainments of the performance benchmarks, as well as, Workforce Investment Act funding reauthorization. Offerors must demonstrate their funding leverage, as outline in the RFP, in case of such an occurrence.

- Q3.** “What are the main reporting requirements for the initial 6 month review and will there be forms or documents provided in July 2012 as a guideline measure to target success?”
- A3.** Reporting requirements and forms to be completed and submitted to WSD will be provided through a Vendors meeting scheduled for July 2012. All subject mater pertaining to reporting and forms, etc. will be addressed at that time with the selected Offeror.
